- 100% of students achieve a "C" or above standard in English

Our initiatives include

- Delivering whole-school approach to the teaching of reading, writing and spelling through differentiated literacy block 4 days a week. (Lemov, D – Teach Like a Champion 2.0, Jossey-Bass, 2015)
- Consult with support staff (STLaN/SWD Teacher) to develop Individual learning plans for those students at risk of not meeting NMS and DDSW Regional Benchmarks in Reading and Numeracy.
- Improving student learning outcomes by intervening early and implementing targeted early-years speech support programs (Fisher, D and Frey, N and Hattie, J – Visible Learning for Literacy, Implementing the Practices That Work Best to Accelerate Student Learning, Corwin, 2016)
- Providing focused and intensive teaching targeted for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement strands.
